Campus Activities - Dodge Ball - Skip Day - Movies - Prayer & Fasting

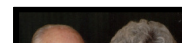

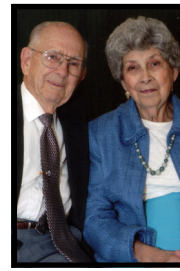
Last Day in the Classroom for Dr. Beckman

He has taught classes every year since and influenced hundreds of students. Many are in ministry today because of his encouragement and inspiration. Two events are planned to honor Dr. Beckman and his wife Martha; Monday evening at 6 pm in the BBC chapel the alumni dinner will include a time of remembering his contribution to hundreds of students and he will be given some time for a final address.
